BALL STRIKER RE- PORT

The regular-season finale deserved something a little different—and the New Jersey Ball Strikers delivered. On Friday, August 28, 23 Strikers stepped away from the weekday routine and headed to Architects in Phillipsburg, Warren County, for the club's inaugural non-weekend event. Beautiful temperatures welcomed the field, the competition carried real consequences, and the finish line of the 2026 season was suddenly close enough to see.

But first, everybody had to do a little walking.

Rain had saturated Architects, leaving the course wet and the carts confined to the paths. Every trip to the ball required a club selection, a little optimism and, occasionally, a return trip for the club you should have brought in the first place. Lift, clean and place in the fairways offered some relief, while water and poor bunker conditions left some traps out of play. The shoes got a workout. So did the nerves. This was the last regular-season opportunity to put points on the board before Neshanic Valley on

Saturday, September 12, and Sunday, September 13—the club's final test of the 2026 season.

And several Strikers made sure they would arrive with something to say.

Avery Hackett Sets the Standard

On a day when the field found plenty of trouble, Avery Hackett posted an 81 to take gross honors by seven strokes. Nobody else broke 88. That is how you put your name on the regular-season finale. Keith Davenport, Greg Cavanaugh and Errol Blake shared second with 88s, followed by George Thomas and Greg Ward at 89. Raymond

Woolfolk finished seventh with 91, Anthony Darby eighth with 92, and DeLano Bonner and Zack Yamba tied for ninth with 93s. Hackett supplied the number to chase. Architects made sure chasing it was no easy assignment.

Errol Blake Cashes In

The net competition belonged to Errol Blake, whose two-under-par 69 was the only net round in red numbers. With the regular season running out of holes, Errol picked a fine time to make his move.

George Thomas and Raymond Woolfolk tied for second at even-par 71, followed by Bruce Arthur at 73 and Burnell Williams at 74. Greg

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Cavanaugh took sixth with 75, Keith Davenport and Greg Ward shared seventh with 76s, and George Weekes and Zack Yamba completed the top ten at 78. For Blake, the net victory was only part of the story. There was still an opponent to beat—and a climb up the season standings to complete.

Match Play: Nobody Was Giving Anything Away

The individual matches brought their own pressure to every group. Some were settled early. Others required every last hole Architects had to offer. In the group featuring Keith Davenport, Greg Cavanaugh, Sebastian Sepulveda and Bruce Arthur, Davenport defeated Cavanaugh 3 & 2. Both posted gross 88s, but Keith claimed the head-to-head points. Arthur left considerably less suspense, defeating Sepulveda 7 & 6, the day's largest winning margin.

Among Avery Hackett, DeLano Bonner, Anthony Darby and Maurice Brown, Hackett added a 5 & 4 victory over Bonner to his gross-scoring honors. Darby and Brown supplied a comeback story. Brown held a five-hole advantage at the turn, but Darby chipped away until the match was level through 16. Two halved holes later, they finished all square, collecting five points apiece. Five down at the turn and still fighting—that is why you keep playing.

In the trio of George Thomas, Raymond Woolfolk and Hugh Lecky, Woolfolk defeated Thomas 4 & 3, pairing his strong net finish with a match-play victory that would reshape the Shippen Cup race. Lecky was officially credited with a win by default, earning 10 match-play points.

The group of Derrick Bethune, George Weekes, Greg Ward and Mike Conrad delivered a convincing win and a final-hole answer. Weekes defeated Bethune 5 & 4. Ward reached the 18th one up against Conrad, but Conrad won the last to finish all square. Five points each—and neither man could afford to dismiss their value.

Among Burnell Williams, Greg Whitaker, Zack Yamba and Charles Smith, the closing holes did the talking. Williams and Whitaker were level through 16 before Williams won the final two for a 2-up victory. Yamba stood one down to Smith through 16, then won 17 and 18 to escape with a 1-up win. With the Shippen Cup leaders packed together, that was a finish with consequences.

In the group featuring Joe McLaughlin, Kirk Hart, Rod LeBrew and Errol Blake, McLaughlin saved his best argument for the end. Two down through 15, Joe won the final three holes to defeat Hart 1 up. Blake completed his big afternoon with a 5 & 3 victory over LeBrew.

For a regular-season farewell, Architects certainly wasn't short on late drama.

Woolfolk Takes the Lead—and the Race Goes to Neshanic

The field collected 320 Shippen Cup points, with Blake's 40-point haul leading the way: 30 for his net victory and 10 for his match win. That performance lifted him six places, from 21st to 15th, with 120 season points. Woolfolk earned 27.5 points,

while Yamba, Davenport, Weekes, Williams and Arthur collected 20 each. Thomas added 17.5, and Ward, McLaughlin, Lecky and Hackett earned 15 apiece.

At the top, those points rearranged the furniture. Entering Architects, current president Mike Conrad led with approximately 221.67 points, barely ahead of Yamba at 221.25, Ward and Cavanaugh tied at 220, and Woolfolk at 216. Five contenders. Fewer than six points between them. One afternoon left before the final test.

Woolfolk seized it. His match victory and share of second in net scoring vaulted him from fifth to first with 243.5 points. Yamba remains second with 241.25, only 2.25 points back. His rally over the final two holes against Smith now looks even bigger.

Ward sits third with 235, Conrad fourth with 231.67, and Cavanaugh fifth with 230. Just 13.5 points separate the top five heading to Neshanic. There is a leader, but there is no room for a victory lap. Behind them, Burnell Williams holds sixth with 199 points, followed by Anthony Darby with 184, Hugh Lecky with 180.42, Joe McLaughlin with 167.5, and Sebastian Sepulveda with 149.33 to complete the top ten. **The regular-season ledger is written. The final chapter is still waiting.**

Stone Tavern: A Proper Regular-Season Send-Off

After the last putts fell, the Strikers headed to Stone Tavern in Phillipsburg to give the afternoon the finish it deserved. The conversation had plenty of material: Hackett's separation from the gross field, Blake's net victory, Woolfolk's climb to first, and enough match-play reversals to keep several tables busy. The shots were replayed, the missed chances revisited, and the fellowship carried on long after the scorecards had done their work.

That is what makes these outings more than a collection of scores. A season's worth of competition builds the standings. The time together builds the club. Architects gave the Strikers a fitting regular-season send-off: a beautiful Friday, a demanding walk, hard-fought matches and a points race still very much alive.

Neshanic Awaits: Three Nines. Two Days. One Final Test.

On Saturday, September 12, and Sunday, September 13, the Ball Strikers head to Neshanic Valley in Somerset County for the Club Championship and the final test of the 2026 season. The destination is set. The assignment remains a mystery. Neshanic's 27-hole championship facility offers three nines: Lake, Ridge and Meadow. Which two will greet the Strikers on each championship day? That answer will remain under wraps until the group arrives.

Throughout the year, Strikers have made their way to Neshanic to build familiarity—learning sightlines, revisiting difficult holes and collecting a little local knowledge for the moment when it matters most. But familiarity comes with a question mark. Will the combination draw on the holes you know best, or send you toward the nine you wish you had played one more time?

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Lake and Ridge? Ridge and Meadow? Meadow and Lake?

The practice rounds may have supplied clues. The championship assignment stays sealed until arrival. That uncertainty adds one more demand to a weekend already carrying plenty: arrive prepared, adjust quickly and commit to the course in front of you. Whatever combination appears on the card, everyone will have to answer it when the scores count most.

Woolfolk brings the Shippen Cup lead. Yamba arrives just 2.25

points behind. Ward, Conrad and Cavanaugh remain close enough to make every point uncomfortable. Across the field, gross and net championship honors offer their own opportunity to turn a season of effort into a finish worth remembering. Two days remain. Three nines hold the possibilities. And somewhere among Lake, Ridge and Meadow, the final chapter of the Ball Strikers' 2026 season is waiting to be played.

Architects set the stage. Neshanic is keeping its cards close.

Strikers—bring your game, bring your resolve, and be ready for whatever nine comes next.
