

BALL STRIKER CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

(revised 9/2/2013)

The Ball Striker club championship will include two rounds of golf. The club champion will be the eligible player who completes the two rounds with the lowest total gross score. Also, the eligible field of players will be divided into flights by handicap index. The number of flights and handicap cutoff points that define the flights will be determined after the full eligible field has been set. Each flight will have a first and second place winner based on lowest total net score. The club champion will not be eligible for flight championships.

Senior Ball Striker members who choose to play from alternate forward tees will not be eligible to compete for the club championship, but can win flight championships.

ELIGIBILITY: All Ball Striker members and selected guests can play in the Club Championship event, but only members meeting the following eligibility criteria can compete for the club championship and flight championships.

- You must be a member in good standing of the New Jersey Ball Striker club.
- You must have participated in at least 50% (rounded up) of the Ball Striker events prior to the Club Championship in the current season. Ball Striker events include all club matches and club events organized by the Ball Strikers (Shippen Cup events). They do not include events sponsored by other organizations that the Ball Strikers support.

FLIGHTS: The flights will be set up using the following guidelines. The eligible members who intend to play both rounds of the championship will be listed by handicap index. Handicap break points for the flights will be selected so that each flight will have approximately the same number of players; that number being at least 4, but not more than 10.

TIE BREAKERS: In case of tie scores, winners will be determined as follows:

- 1st TIE BREAKER – Lowest score for the second round.
- 2nd TIE BREAKER – Lowest score for the back nine of the second round.
- 3rd TIE BREAKER – Match of cards starting with the #1 handicap hole score for the second round.
- 4th TIE BREAKER – Match of cards starting with the #1 handicap hole score for the first round.
